Does your service provider’s Worker Compensation Experience Modification Rate (EMR) indicate unsafe practices?

Direct Push Analytical Corp.’s latest EMR was 0.05. The lower the number, the lower the claims and directly correlated to proper training and education. Typically, an EMR of 1.0 or higher requires explanation.

Is your service provider appropriately and sufficiently insured should a catastrophe strike?

Per industry standard contracts typical policies include the following minimum requirements with limits of at least:

- Employee Liability \$ 1,000,000 per occurrence
- Commercial General and Contractual Liability \$ 1,000,000 per occurrence
- Automobile Liability \$ 1,000,000 per occurrence
- Pollution Liability \$ 1,000,000 per occurrence

Direct Push Analytical maintains policies covering the above limits as well as an Umbrella Liability policy of \$4,000,000 in the aggregate.
